- ✦ Help us to know your child by making sure they wear a name tag! Name tags are located on the back wall of the Narthex. If you don't have one, please [click here](#) to request a name tag to be made or let an usher know and one will be made for your child. If you are visiting St. Luke's Church, please fill out a nametag on one of the Visitor's tables.
- ✦ At the "Kid's Corner" station, there are baskets with brightly-colored Children's Worship folders, crayons and activity sheets. It's okay to let your child draw or color in church...they are paying more attention than you think!
- ✦ Children are welcome to stay with you for the entire service. However, we do offer Children's Chapel during the 11:00 a.m. service for both preschool and elementary. **Click here** to learn more about Children's Chapel.
- ✦ During the Peace, pass the Peace to your child and to the other children around you saying, "**Peace be with you.**" Invite your children to do the same!
- ✦ After announcements, there is a time for recognizing birthdays. Bring your child forward to bless their special day!
- ✦ Give your child an offering to place in the Offering plate. Remember, no offering is too small!

**Receiving Communion:** Once your child has been baptized, they are welcome to receive communion at St. Luke's Church. After baptism, it is up to you as their parents to decide when they will begin to participate in the Eucharist. If you prefer, children can receive a blessing instead of communion
